

COMPETITION RULES 2018 - HOLE No 2

Hole No 2 - Option 1

Any ball coming to rest on the banking directly in front of the green and inside the area designated by PURPLE stakes shall be deemed to be in an area of “abnormal ground condition”

Any ball coming to rest within this area may be lifted and dropped below the road and outside the area marked by purple stakes on the lower banking. The ball must be dropped within one club length of the nearest point of relief keeping a line as near as possible to the place where the initial ball was played to.

Relief taken under this rule is with no penalty.

Hole No 2 - Option 2

Any ball coming to rest on the banking directly in front of the green and inside the area designated by PURPLE stakes shall be deemed to be in an area of “abnormal ground condition”

Any ball coming to rest within this area may be lifted and play commenced from the drop zone at the top of the road. The ball must be dropped within the drop zone.

Relief taken under this option carries a one stroke penalty.

**There is no option to play the ball as it lies within the area of abnormal ground condition.**

***Players are strongly discouraged from attempting to recover any ball coming to rest in any of the areas described above.***

***Council considered these areas to be hazardous, especially in wet weather.***

***You are strongly advised to avoid these areas of the course.***

***You are worth more than a golf ball.***
