Changes to Hole 2 and Hole 9

8th December 2018

Changes to 2nd and 9th Holes

Starting with the easy one first, the 9th, the area to right of the 9th fairway, otherwise known as the Glen, will now be classed as Out of Bounds. The Greens staff will be putting out white pegs to delineate the OOB. Usual rules apply, "If your ball is lost outside a water hazard or out of bounds you must play another ball from the spot where the last shot was played, under penalty of one stroke, i.e. stroke and distance."

This is effective immediately.

Now onto the trickier of the the two, the 2nd.

The slope immediately below the second green, bounded by the road, is to be considered as an abnormal ground condition, as such any ball coming to rest on the slope must not be played. The area will be defined by coloured stakes as soon as possible.

Players have the option to drop a ball on the tee, or proceed to the drop zone at the top of the road under no penalty, only the strokes taken to be counted. The ball must be dropped and not teed.

Under the current local rule relief must be taken.

Council strongly recommends that players do not look for a ball that has come to rest on the slope below the second green.

This will remain in effect until the end of the winter season, before the start of next season I will have in place a ruling to cover the second for medal play which will still take away the choice of playing from the bank.

A sign will be put up at the bottom of the bank advising players not to climb on the bank for any reason.

No shots may be played from the bank. **Effective immediately.**

These changes are necessary and sensible, again players are requested not to look for a ball lost on the banking in front of the 2nd.
